BIBLICAL COSTUMES

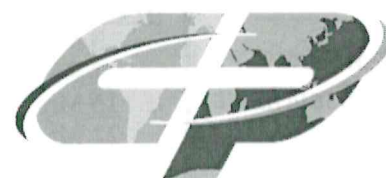

From the Director of Missions

This past week I had the opportunity to meet with the Administrative Council. We reviewed the many activities of Green River. To begin with, I shared what we have been doing about the Soup Kitchen and the grant monies we received last fall. I shared how we have finished some much-needed plumbing for the kitchen and chapel. The lighting situation has been fixed and I am happy to say that we have upgraded the lights with LED lighting. Along with this we have finished the building repairs and painting on the exterior of the village.

I would ask you to be in prayer for us this summer as we continue work in the village. We have a second opportunity to apply for this grant. There are other items where we could improve the soup kitchen area and it would help us as we minister to others. We are also praying about adding an additional ministry to the village.

I want you to know that there have been several people who received Christ because of the Chapel Ministry. We are looking for people to help with this ministry. If you will contact the office, we will get you in touch with the person who is in charge. There is always a need for helpers in the soup kitchen. Let the office know if you are interested.

I also shared with the council about the Inreach Team's challenge to our churches to have an Associational Wide Lay Renewal this fall. During the April Quarterly Meeting Bob Foy will lay out the program and then invite our churches to participate. He will explain the process in April, then set up to come to your church to explain the process and then invite the individual church to participate. I will send a letter and brochure to each pastor for his consideration. We already have 5-6 churches who expressed an interest. The Inreach Team has set up the weekend of October 20, 21, 22 for the Lay Renewal. Then, in our October 30 Quarterly Meeting, they are going to ask the churches that participated to share.

Add to all of this, I shared how our associational committees are hard at work, too. The Building and Grounds Committee met to assess the possible needs to seek grant help. The Advisory Committee met in the matters of West Point and their recommendation to receive them as full members in Green River. The committees are all meeting and working together. We have worked on Deacon Training, the Mountain State Fair, and even a second Deacon Training this fall.

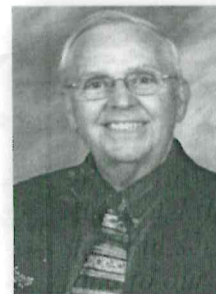

HOST CHURCHES NEEDED: Mission Serve is returning to Rutherford County July 22-29 to share the love of Jesus Christ by providing urgently needed repairs for those in need through Rutherford Housing Partnership.

The youth groups are housed at Florence Baptist in Forest City. Upon arrival, each young person is assigned to a work crew led by several adults, including at least one skilled in construction or rehab. Currently we plan to have 13-15 work crews of 10-15 people each. Each crew will be assigned to a project, which might be roofing, painting, building wheelchair ramps or providing other home repairs.

Host churches agree to adopt a work crew for the week, providing a place for Sunday school, worship and lunch on Sunday, July 23; preparing or providing lunches on the work site each day, Monday-Friday; and praying for the crew throughout their stay here.

We will try our best to assign churches to crews that are working close to the church, but there are times when the Host Church might have to drive a little way to deliver food to their crew. Contact us for more details.
